

ZAMBEZI CLASSIC COMPETITION RULES

Zambezi Classic is a species tournament that is structured in such a way to challenge the skills of the angler. The Competition shall include 9 species of fish with a maximum of 10 fish per species, except tiger and Vundu/barbel Maximum of six tiger and Maximum of six vundu/Barbel for the comp, being allowed for weigh in over the competition. This is a catch and release competition and there will a prize for the most live fish released and dead fish will only receive half points. See table below.

SPECIES	MINIMUM WEIGHT	POINTS
Tiger Fish	1 kg	2 points per Kg
Bream (all species)	200 gms	5 points per Kg
Chessa	200 gms	3 points per Kg
Nkupi	500 gms	3 points per kg
Vundu or Barbel	1kg	0.6 points per kg
Bottlenose	1 kg	2 points per Kg
cornish Jack	1 Kg	2 points per kg
squeaker (all species)	Each	1 point per fish
Imberi	Each	1 point per fish
Unusual species (Yellow fish, Electric Barbel, Eel, Dwarf tiger, parrot fish)	1 fish of each species for comp	10 points

For full quota of each species you get a bonus of 10 points.

1. Under weight fish will attract a 10 point penalty and a check scale will be available at the weigh in.
2. More than the allowed quota of 10 fish will also attract a 10 point penalty per fish.
3. We will allow photographic evidence of the tiger fish and scale. This photo must show the weight, the fish, the date and the angler. It must also be witnessed by your nearest competitor.
4. Captains meeting shall be held at 19.00 hrs the day before the competition in the Gwabi lodge camp site.
5. Start time will be at 7.00 am and weigh in will be at 16.30 hrs for day one and two. Day three the start time will be at 6.00 am and the weigh in will be at 14.30 hrs.
6. Lateness for weigh in will result in that days catch being forfeited. If a team is unable to make weigh in on time they may allow another team to take their catch to weigh in on their behalf.
7. Only the official clock will be recognized for time keeping.
8. Teams can be made up of the following: 4 adults or 3 adults 2 children or 2 adults 3 children or 1 adults 4 children. Juniors shall be persons of the age 16 or below.
9. There is no limit on line class or number of rods an angler can use at one time.
